

NOTICE OF PROPERTY TAX INCREASE

The Putnam County Board of Commissioners has tentatively adopted a millage rate which will require an increase in property taxes by 12.49 percent for the incorporated area and 13.45 percent for the unincorporated area. All concerned citizens are invited to the public hearing on this tax increase to be held at the Putnam County Administration Building, 117 Putnam Drive, Eatonton, GA on September 2, 2016 at 9:00 a.m.

Times and places of additional public hearings on this tax increase are at the Putnam County Administration Building, 117 Putnam Drive, Eatonton, GA on August 25, 2016 11:30 a.m. and August 25, 2016 6:00 p.m.

Incorporated area:

This tentative increase will result in a millage rate of 9.001 mills for the incorporated area of the County, an increase of 1.0 mill. Without this tentative tax increase, the millage rate will be no more than 8.001 mills. The proposed tax increase for a home with a fair market value of \$200,000 is approximately \$70.00 and the proposed tax increase for non-homestead property with a fair market value of \$150,000 is approximately \$60.00.

Unincorporated area:

This tentative increase will result in a millage rate of 8.437 mills for the unincorporated area of the County, an increase of 1.0 mill. Without this tentative tax increase, the millage rate will be no more than 7.437 mills. The proposed tax increase for a home with a fair market value of \$200,000 is approximately \$70.00 and the proposed tax increase for non-homestead property with a fair market value of \$150,000 is approximately \$60.00.
