Putnam County Board of Tax Assessors – Minutes – June 8, 2021

The Putnam County Board of Tax Assessors held a regular business meeting on Tuesday, June 8, 2021 in the Tax Assessors office. Chairman Shelby Storey called the meeting to order at 3:01pm.

Minutes from the regular business meeting held on May 11, 2021 were reviewed by the board. In a motion made by Richter and seconded by Reese, the minutes were unanimously approved. Minutes from the special-called meeting held on May 20, 2021 were then reviewed by the board. In a motion made by Reese and seconded by Richter, the minutes were unanimously approved.

Chief Appraiser Anglin gave an update on 2021 appeals. To date, there have been thirty-three (33) appeals filed, and five (5) of those have been submitted online. Mr. Anglin presented one appeal filed for exemption denial (#109B-041). Homestead was denied in the April meeting because the taxpayer failed to provide proof of residency. Upon filing the appeal, the taxpayer provided the required proof of residency. In a motion made by Reese and seconded by Richter, the board unanimously approved homestead, thereby resolving the appeal. Mr. Anglin then presented an appraisal submitted with an appeal (#057C-005) to the board for review. In a motion made by Richter and seconded by Reese, the board unanimously rejected the appraisal due to the use of retrospective sales. Copy of appraisal rejection letter sent to taxpayer attached in the minutes.

Eleven (11) Notices of Assessment were then reviewed by the board. In a motion made Richter and seconded by Reese, the board approved the mailing of two (2) "45-day" notices on latefiled personal properties (Acct #71238 & Acct #73940). In a motion made by Reese and seconded by Richter, the board approved the mailing of nine (9) 2nd notices ("30 day"):
